Safe Return to School Plan

Plan for Safe Return to In-Person Instruction and Continuity of Services

Important Dates

This plan will be reviewed August 11, 2022, and with any changes in local health department requirements. We have offered 100% in-person learning since August 2020. Decisions related to COVID-19 are made/updated weekly at Leadership meetings.

In-Person and/or Remote Options

CRC Day Treatment offers 100% in person learning. We offer a fully remote option when necessary in order to meet CDC and local health department requirements.

Social, Emotional, Mental, and other Needs

Chromebooks and online instructional programs were purchased to ensure equitable access for all students if remote learning is required. Staff participate in PD to help them feel comfortable providing instruction in a variety of formats. KN95 masks as well as at home tests are provided to staff. A water bottle refill station was installed and our program works with home school districts to provide food options for families in need.

Layered Prevention Strategies

- Physical Distancing- desks are spaced 6 feet apart in all classrooms
- Consistent and correct mask use required for all staff and students
- Nonessential visitors are limited, visitors must wear a mask
- Ventilation- system was assessed and met all requirements, higher grade filter was installed
- Handwashing- encouraged, hand sanitizer available from locked desk
- Students and staff are required to stay home when sick/getting tested
- Utilizing a cohort model to reduce contacts and exposures
- Cleaning and Disinfection- company hired to clean and disinfect daily to meet local health department requirements, staff disinfect teacher desk after each move, student desks disinfected daily, offices disinfected after meetings with students/staff

Phased Prevention

Local Health Department Information
CRC has a designated point person who is in communication with the local health department. She updates all of the CRC COVID guidance based on real-time changes. CRC created an online tracking system for staff who are symptomatic, have been exposed, or who have tested positive. This system/data is used to determine quarantine and isolation requirements.

How Decisions will be Made about Preventative Actions

- The number of COVID cases or quarantines amongst staff and students
- Following CDC and local health department guidance
- Evaluating consistency in following prevention strategies
