

TITLE IX GRIEVANCE FORM



Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 ("Title IX"), 20 U.S.C. §1681 et seq., is a Federal civil rights law that prohibits discrimination on the basis of sex in education programs and activities, including decisions about admission and employment. One form of discrimination is sexual harassment, defined as conduct on the basis of sex that satisfies one or more of the following:

- A school employee conditioning the provision of an aid, benefit, or service of the school on an individual's participation in unwelcome sexual conduct (often called "quid pro quo" harassment);
- Unwelcome conduct determined by a reasonable person to be so severe, pervasive, and objectively offensive that it effectively denies a person equal access to the school's education program or activity; or
- Sexual assault as defined in 20 U.S.C. 1092(f)(6)(A)(v), dating violence as defined in 34 U.S.C. 12291(a)(10), domestic violence as defined in 34 U.S.C. 12291(a)(8), or stalking as defined in 34 U.S.C. 12291(a)(30).

The **Day Treatment** program at Community Reach Center complies with Title IX. Any **Day Treatment** student or professional who has experienced or witnessed sexual harassment can make a report to the Title IX Coordinator at any time.
